VRC members will be able to purchase up to three visitor tickets (one for the member and up to two for guests) to enter the MCC Members' Reserve for the following matches to be played at the MCG in the AFL 2024 Premiership Season.

Current financial VRC members for the 2023/24 season will have access to seating on levels 1 and 4 of the MCC Members' Reserve. VRC members can either pre-purchased reserved seat tickets or general admission tickets which will provide access to unreserved seating, subject to capacity.

Tickets can be booked in advance through Ticketek or at the Gate 2 ticket window on match days, subject to availability.

When purchasing a MCC visitor ticket, VRC members must quote the valid barcode number located on their membership card.

Access to the MCC Members' Reserve will be via Gate 2, which is located near the corner of Jolimont Street and Terrace. VRC members and their guests will be able to utilise all the excellent bar, café and dining facilities in the Reserve with the exception of the Long Room, Members' Dining Room, Missymu by Shirley, and Jim Stynes Grill.

The minimum dress standard in the Members' Reserve is neat casual for both men and women. Please note that gentlemen must wear a collared shirt, irrespective of whether or not a collared sweater or jacket is being worn over the top.
